## PRESS RELEASE

In response to Governor Roy Cooper declaring a state of emergency in North Carolina regarding COVID-19 (Coronavirus) and the Judicial Branch activating its public health policy, the Forsyth County Clerk of Superior Court will reduce its hours of operation and staff availability, effective, Monday, April 13, 2020.

The Forsyth County Clerk of Superior Court's Office, located at 200 N. Main Street, Winston-Salem, North Carolina 27101, will be open to the public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00am and 2:00pm. The telephone number is (336) 779-6300. All visitors are screened before entry will be allowed.

In order to limit exposure, Attorneys and the public are to use our drop box system for filings which is located at the front entrance of the Hall of Justice. We strongly encourage everyone to handle all other business by using our website at [forsythcountyclerk.com](http://forsythcountyclerk.com) or [nccourts.gov](http://nccourts.gov), telephone, regular mail, and email. Upset bids will only be accepted between 9:00am and 2:00pm. Only emergency and essential filings (e.g., a domestic violence protective order, temporary restraining order, juvenile custody order, time sensitive bond forfeitures, etc.) will be accepted by the Clerk's Office between 2:00pm and 5:00pm.

This schedule change will be effective until June 1, 2020 but may be extended, in whole or in part, if deemed necessary.
