Beginning Monday, November 2, 2020, the Clerk of Superior Court's Office, in the Forsyth County Hall of Justice will be open to Attorneys and the Public for **emergency** and **non-emergency** filings between the hours of **9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.** (noon) Monday-Friday.

Filings and drop-offs will be accepted in room 203.

Only emergency and essential filings (e.g., a domestic violence protective order, temporary restraining order, juvenile custody order, time sensitive bond forfeitures, etc.) will be accepted by the Clerk's Office between 12:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. in room 203. For emergency and essential filings, the Clerk's Office will only accept business checks, cashier's check, or money order for payment of court cost.
